

## HOLME-NEXT-THE-SEA PARISH COUNCIL

### DECEMBER 2012 MEETING

The Clerk reported that the result of the election for the Police and Crime Commissioner had been posted on the three Notice Boards used for Parish Council notices. Stephen Bett had been elected.

Notices have been posted on the Parish Notice Boards asking that anyone interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, to fill the current casual vacancy, should contact the Parish Clerk by 28th February 2013. A notice will also appear in the Link magazine.

There were no members of the public in attendance, but in the public participation time Councillor Watson reported that the decision regarding the Incinerator will be made by Norfolk County Council, not the Borough Council. The alternative now proposed is deemed to be superior.

The Planning Application relating to the Children's Climbing frame at The White Horse had been granted. An application had been made for the demolition of an existing seasonal holiday accommodation chalet and replacement with a new one at land east of Seabank on Broadwater Road. It was agreed an objection should be lodged to this application and also a general concern raised regarding the damage done by developers to verges and private roads.

Information had been supplied by contractors employed by the Environment Agency advising of remedial work to 15 sea defence groynes on the beach between Old Hunstanton and Holme. This will involve either repair or replacement of the baskets of flint stone of which they are composed. It is anticipated the work will start in late January on the section to be accessed via Sea Lane, Old Hunstanton and in March on the section to be accessed via Beach Road, Holme. All work should be completed by the end of March, weather permitting.

The Deed of Dedication for Park Piece as a Field in Trust was signed and it was agreed the a notice requesting suggestions as to a monument to display the Jubilee plaque should be inserted in the Link magazine and displayed on all three Parish Notice Boards. Suggestions are to be made to the Parish Clerk by 28th February 2013.

A donation towards the cost of grass cutting in St. Mary's Churchyard was agreed to be given to the Parochial Church Council and various payments were agreed including Clerk's salary, street lighting maintenance, a charity donation to Magpas (the Emergency Medical Charity), and the refund of village sign plant costs.

The January meeting will be held on Tuesday, 8th January at 7.30 pm, in the Village Hall. Members of the public are welcome to attend and put their comments and questions to Councillors during 'Public Participation'.
