

**HOLME-NEXT-THE-SEA PARISH COUNCIL**  
**ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**  
**held on 14TH MAY 2013**

At the Annual General Meeting of the Parish Council meeting that followed the Annual Parish Meeting, Councillor Myles was elected Chairman, Councillor Felgate was elected Vice Chairman and Derek Young was welcomed as a new Councillor.

The Clerk reported that the bid for funding for LED street lighting had been submitted and the Parish will be notified of the result during the summer. The Police Support Officer reported no recorded crimes in the previous month.

A Planning Applications for consent to general repair work at 43 Kirkgate had been submitted and confirmation of the retrospective granting of permission for the erection of a log type cable on land south of Morning Light in Busseys Lane had been received. Concerns regarding the procedure relating to Lawful Development Certificates were raised and the Parish Council will continue to raise these issues with the Borough Council.

Procedural reviews required further time and were postponed until the next meeting. Insurance provision was considered with the Local Council renewal being agreed for payment and the Village Hall renewal being deferred as it was not immediately due. Approved payments included street lighting, village green and orchard land maintenance, donations to the Samaritans and the Citizens Advice Bureau and Clerk's salary. There was confirmation that the end of year returns for HM Revenue & Customs had been submitted on line in relation to the Clerk's employment.

Maintenance work to the Village Hall windows was approved and there was further discussion of future internal maintenance required together with suggestions for an improved layout of the washroom and storage area in the Hall. These will be considered further at the next meeting. It was confirmed that the accounts had been successfully audited for the previous year.

The next meeting of Holme-next-the-Sea Parish Council will be held on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at 7.30pm**. Members of the public are welcome to attend and put their questions and comments to the Councillors during 'public participation'.
